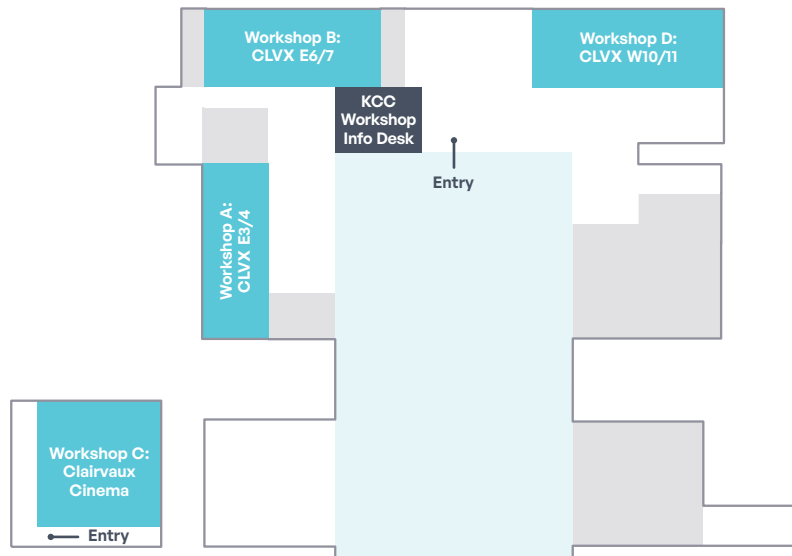

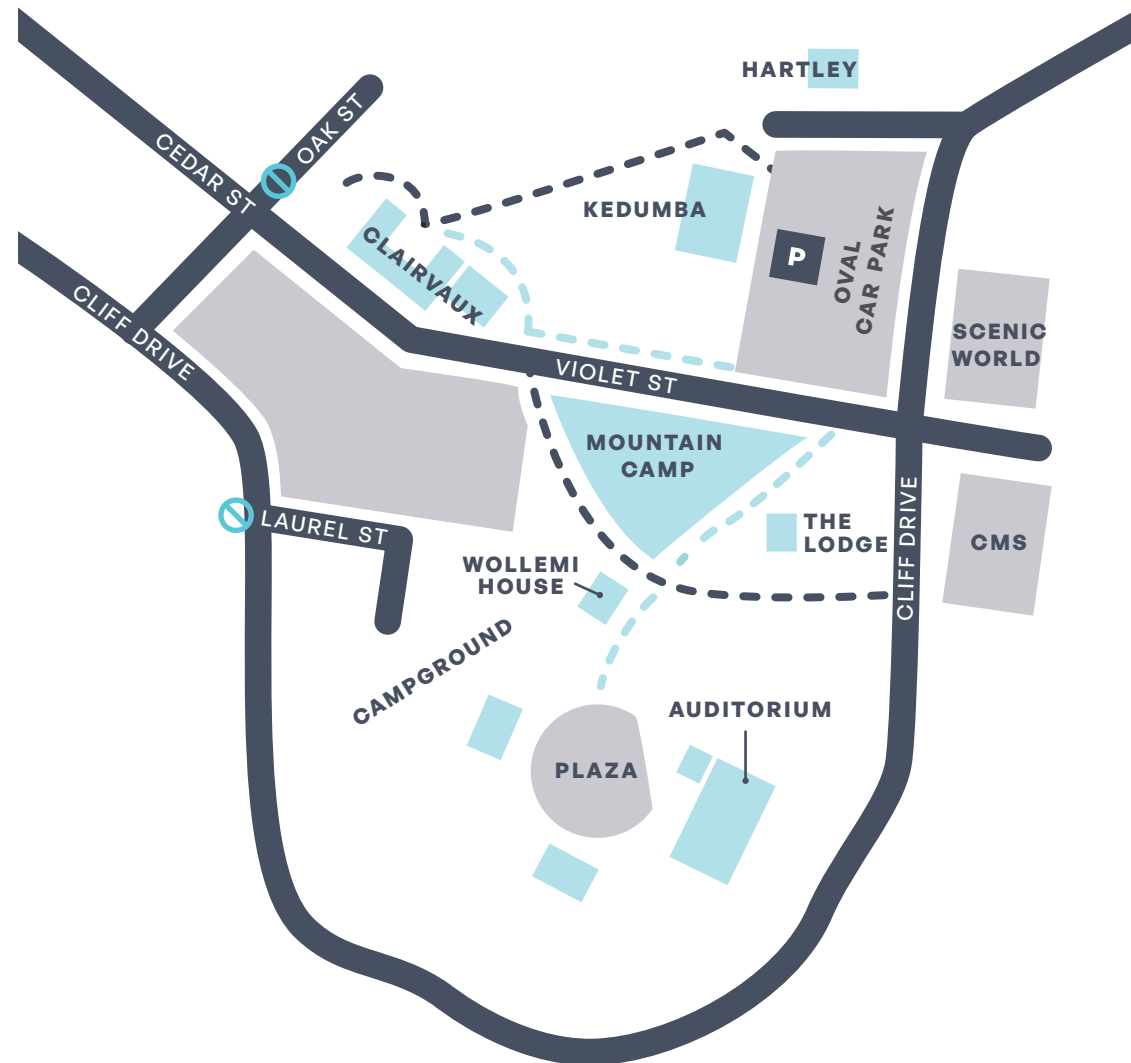
CONVENTION MAP

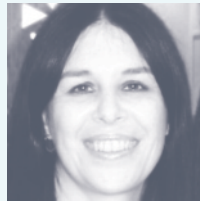

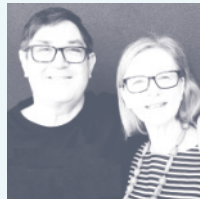

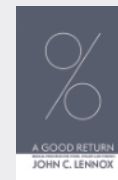

John Lennox

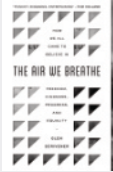
